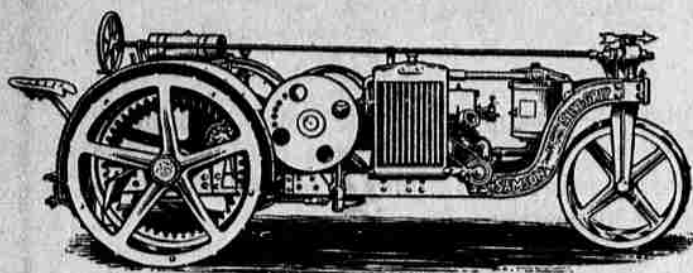

BOMB FRAGMENTS POISON 25 LONDON PEOPLE

London, July 25.—(By mail)—(United Press)—Serious skin infection caused by the ashes of high-explosive bomb-powder, will probably deter Londoners from picking up bomb fragments in future air raids. Three weeks after the big raid that killed over 100 people, 25 persons were reported to be suffering from a strange ailment—their hands were swollen and the skin was suffering from a new kind of irritation.

Hospital authorities identified the trouble as that which frequently attacks munition workers who handle T. N. T. The trouble starts within a few hours after the hands touch the bomb fragments and the disease is progressive unless checked by medical attention.
