Marines Taught Rifle Shooting On Giant Range

—With a realization of the fact that "seven-tenths of a soldier's business is shooting and shooting quickly and accurately," the giant Marine Corps Rifle Range here is being worked to its fullest capacity. Hundreds of Marine Corps officers and men are weekly taking the full course of instruction in rifle shooting as applied to modern warfare.

More than 73 per cent of the members of the Marine Corps who fired the prescribed course during 1916 are qualified expert riflemen, sharpshooters or marksmen. Marine Corps officials believe that, with modern efficiency and equipment, even a greater

percentage of the new Marine Corps will not only distinguish themselves on the rifle range but on the firing line in France, as well.
