TRY TO CHECK VICE

Enterprise, Sept. 29.—(Special.)—The Enterprise-Record Chieftain says: "As a start toward curbing the way-

wardness of certain young men and girls of town, Dick Shear was held to the grand jury on Monday by Justice A. B. Conaway, on the testimony of Callie Lutje, 15 years old. Shear's

bond was fixed at \$2500. He did not furnish bail and is in the county jail. The Lutje girl and several companions of about the same age are detained, and June Baker was brought from La Grande on Tuesday and locked up here. She is said to have contributed to the delinquency of the young girls. The names of many men are also in the hands of Sheriff Rinehart and Prosecutor Fairchild, and it is the intention that none mixed up in the mess shall escape prosecution. When the first arrest of girls was made last week a number of young men took alarm and left town on the first train. A restaurant is said to play an important part in the spread of vice, affording a headquarters for the older women and young men who lead the girls astray."
