Water Superintendent Hoyt reports work progressing satisfactorily at Beaver Creek. He has removed trash from in front of dam, cleaned Beaver Creek channel of submerged rubbish and limbs and has taken much of the decayed vegetable matter from the bottom of reservoir. He has also opened main pipe line at a point where pipe takes first raise to climb out of Beaver Canyon. It was expected to find sand and gravel lodged in pipe line but none was discovered. He is now rebuilding bridge across Beaver Creek and protecting pipe line against Winter high water. Will probably bring crew in this evening as balance of the work can be done at a better advantage from this end.
Work of filling subway is progressing rapidly. Contractor Phillips being able to handle dirt as fast as the railroad company can deliver it.
Have sent additional samples of Beaver Creek water to State Health Board to determine quantity of algae, a vegetable growth, present in the water supply. It is this that causes color and odor. It is necessary to know the quantity and formation of the growth in order to determine proper method of correction.
Water Superintendent Hoyt being absent, we are unable to make a report for his department.
The treasurer reports that nearly all of the warrants called in recent call have been presented for payment. Pursuant to instructions from the Commission, bonds have been called as per advertisement.
