GEO COHAN IN MYSTERY FARCE

George Washington Magee, a novelist, makes a wager with the owner of Baldpate Inn that he can write a story in 24 hours. Seeking seclusion, Magee borrows the key to Baldpate, a summer hotel now locked up for the winter, and with his typewriter retires to an upper room of the deserted hostelry to write his story. There enters the hotel office one John Bland, an employe of a street railway magnate, who places \$200,000 in the hotel safe—a bribe to be called for later by the Mayor of Reuton. Magee surprises Bland, who draws a pistol, but a moment later the novelist tricks him and locks him in a room. Forthwith, however, Magee is confronted by a third intruder, Mary Norton, a newspaper reporter on the trail of the bribery affair. Magee falls in love with Mary and complications crowd still more closely upon one another's heels. In all, seven persons, includ-

ing Peter, a strange old hermit, come to "lonely" Baldpate that night. As expressed by the author, the hotel seems to have as many keys as a piano. All the keys are in the hands of particularly interesting people who come on mysterious missions, even murder, giving the novelist, as well as the audience, all the excitement they could possibly ask for. This is as much of the story of "Seven Keys to Baldpate" as would be fair to reveal. There is a unique solution to the problem, worked out in George M. Cohan's highly dramatic and original manner, presenting in all a particularly entertaining film, as the current attraction of the Arcade Theatre.

DRAFTED MEN WILL FILL UP NATIONAL GUARD

(United Press) Washington, D. C., Oct. 15.—The War Department announced that it will transfer men from the National Army to the National Guard camps so as to bring the latter organizations to war strength. Practically every section of the country is affected. Camp Lewis, Tacoma, sends 3000 to California, Nevada and Utah quotas to the Fortieth division. Arrangements for transportation will be made by the commanding general of the Western Department.

In the National league there is probably no better liked man than Pat Moran, manager of the Philadelphia team. Taking charge of a loser in 1915, Manager Moran won a pennant for the

This is the substance of a reported deal that Colonel Jake Ruppert is about to put over and which will cost the owners of the New York American league club about \$100,000. According to the sponsors of the rumor of this gigantic deal, the transfer of those stars will be made possible by sacrificing Washington as a big league city. The owners of the club in Washington are about ready to quit. Baseball at the capital is a losing investment even when the Senators are up with the leaders.

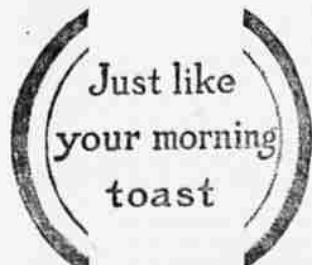
