SOMETHING ABOUT ALGAE

To the Editor: The public is gratefully informed by the General Manager's weekly reports that he is still wrestling with "algae," the great enemy to sanitary water in the various reservoirs of our water system. Everything antagonistic to public water comfort seems to be the "decay of vegetable growth." The nauseating condition of Beaver water of a few weeks ago, wherein much sickness was produced was attributed to this so-called vegetable growth. The accumulated horse-dung, camp refuse, chips, bark and decaying tree-stumps negligently left in the reservoir when the water was turned in at the completion of the dam, in their natural decay is denominated by this astute manager as vegetable matter rather than by their proper names. Rather far-fetched but still "algae." Of course the numerous horses employed in constructing the dam and reservoir, being strict vegetarians ate only "vegetable matter" such as grass and its matured condition such as hay and oats and the ultimate result was still vegetable matter. So, lately water from the Grande Ronde River at low stage has been pumped into the city's water supply with all its "decaying vegetable matter." Some object to this supply, but when it is considered that the blood and refuse from the slaughter-house and the sewage of a dozen families along the river banks from Hilgard to the pump are but "decaying vegetable matter" the public should be content, notwithstanding results. Did not the dying beehives before their slaughter consume only vegetation and since "all flesh is grass" why should any criticism be passed? It is true the public may boll the drinking water, even if the nose has to be held during the boiling the trouble is compensated by the "vegetable" soup obtained by the process. So Limberger cheese, a product of much odor is said to be made from milk, and did not the cows or goats eat vegetable matter? Hence, is not this active cheese the ultimatum of vegetation? Since many persons, even of good judgment object to its flavor, why not call it Algae, or boll it and eat the stuff palatable? There should be "open seasons" for the pursuit and extermination of Algae, the arch enemy of the water system, that the public may get at it, since the management seems to be incompetent to keep its growth from decay and injury to the necessary water supply. A similar attempt to hood-wink the public must have wrung from Shakespeare his famous exclamation: "What fools these mortals be." Respectfully,

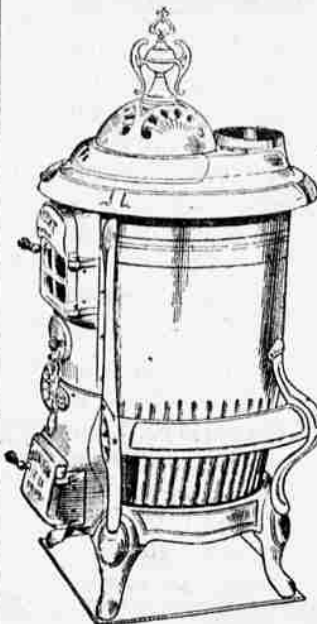
