SENTRY LEARNS SOMETHING DIDN'T KNOW BEFORE.

CAMP LEWIS, Oct. 26.—The sentry was walking his post in the most approved military style. Along came Brigadier General Styler. The sentry didn't salute.

"Guard haven't you been instructed to salute your officers?" General Styler asked.

"Gwan," you cavalry guys think you can fool us infantrymen with your funny clothes. We're wise, boy."

The sentry received a practical lesson in how to identify a high Army officer without delay.

A revolt in Austria is near. The German people will strip the Kaiser of his power, but will not force him to step from his throne.

The world war will end early next year, peace coming through the efforts of President Wilson and the Pope.

Germany will be compelled to surrender all captured Russian, Belgian and French territory and will pay great indemnities.

That today is the prediction of Private Selim Shoueke, member of a family which for 300 years has seen into the future and himself an astrologer of no mean ability. He is an Egyptian.

Shoueke foretold the election of Mayor Mitchel of New York years before Mitchel entered politics and named the month the United States would get into the great war eight months before America declared war, he said today.

Shoueke now is learning how to be a soldier. He will probably be used as interpreter in France as he speaks and reads several languages.

Seven and a half miles of woolen made a part of one meal recently for the men stationed here. The average daily consumption of meat is 35,000 pounds. Six thousand pounds of onions are used daily in the camp kitchens. Other food is used in proportion.

Army physicians said today that most rejections from the new National Army were due to tuberculosis of either the lungs or bones. Defective eyesight has also caused a large number of rejections. Several sleepwalkers have been sent back home. Army authorities explain the somnambulist not only "gets on the nerves" of his fellow soldiers, but he also risks his own life unnecessarily in the Army. He might wander out on "No Man's Land" or in some other equally dangerous place.

SENTAOR CHAMBERLAIN TO SPEND MONTH AT HOME

ONE-FIFTH OF AUTOS IN U. S. WEST OF ROCKIES.

OLYMPIA, Oct. 26.—The Pacific Coast is the happy hunting ground of the automobile salesman, auto dealers' figures show. One-fifth of the Nation's automobile output is placed west of the Rocky Mountains where the people have the money and the inclination to buy machines. And, of these Western States Washington ranks high, according to figures obtained here today in the office of the secretary of state.
