CAMP LEWIS, TACOMA, Wash., Oct. 27.—Woke up. If you don't know how, you may get killed. It's the fraction of a second that counts. A fifth of a second may save your life—or kill you. Get some snap, lie, ginger into your actions. Get into the pink of condition—and stay that way. These are the thoughts being pounded into the heads of 45,000 men in training here. The officers are impressing the men with the importance of accurate action. Speed in thrusting a bayonet, or firing a rifle may mean the life of any one of the men in personal combat with a German. Major General Greene has issued a bulletin dealing with this subject and with the necessity of the greatest attention to drills and discipline all the time.
