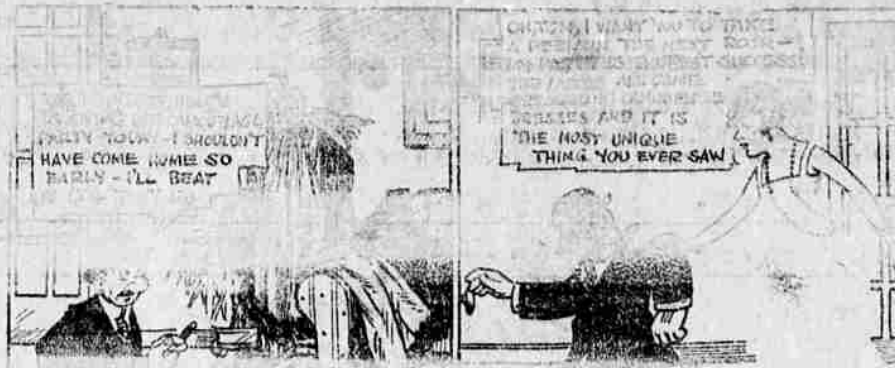

Portland, Nov. 12.—(Special.)—Mr. J. D. Farrell, President of the Oregon-Washington Railroad & Navigation Company, a member of the Committee on National Defense, reads to be the biggest potato crop in the history of the country. This crop, which is estimated at 1,000,000 bushels, is being raised on 1,000,000 acres of land in the middle of September. The movement of it will continue until about April first, next year. Reports received by the Commission for the Service indicate that even with the intensive feeding now being given to the stock it is needed to handle the potato crop.
