### PUSH BUTTON SHIPS NO LONGER A DREAM

(United Press.)

LONDON, Oct. 28.—(By Mail.)—Britain is becoming very much interested in the electrically propelled ship, which was first developed on a large scale by the United States Navy.

The editor of the Electric Times in a recent interview said:

"The electric ship is no longer a dream but a reality, and I should not be surprised to find, within a few years of the close of the war, every new vessel of any size driven, steered, stopped, reversed or turned merely by pressing a series of buttons on the bridge.

"British shipbuilders now have their eyes on the possibilities of the electric drive for big liners and merchant ships, and it is hardly to be questioned that our admiralty is less alive than the United States navy department to the superior merits of the system."
