

SECOND ORDNANCE CLASS OPENS

Members Will Enter Active Service When Course is Completed.

EUGENE, Ore., Nov. 19.—With men from practically every state west of the Rocky mountains attending, the second ordinance school opened at the University of Oregon here today.

The men will be trained in special ordinance work, taking a course of study outlined by the war department. Upon completion of the

course they immediately enter active service in a government arsenal.

The first class at the ordinance school completed its course a week ago and left immediately for San Antonio, Texas.

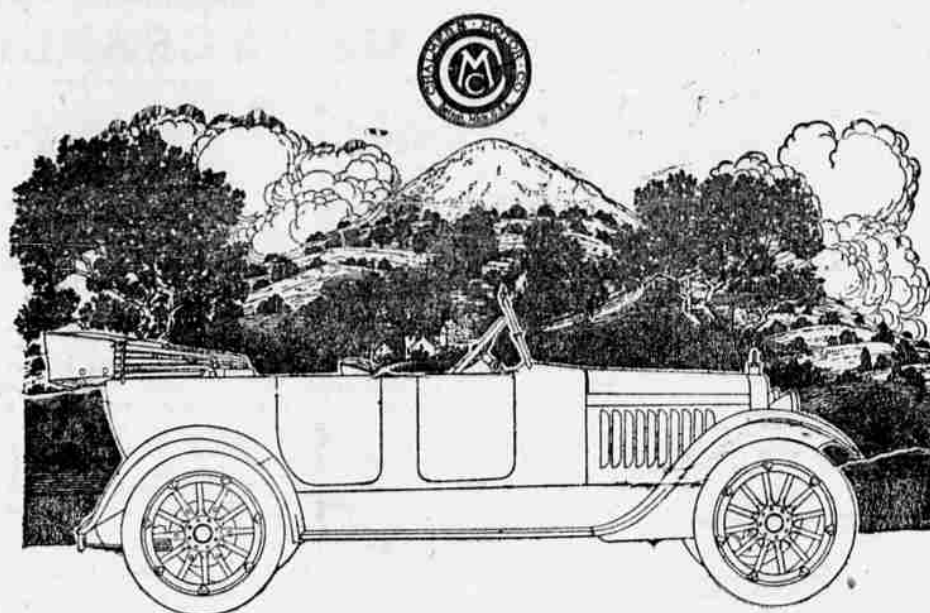
