The plant has \$60,000 invested and employs between 80 and 100 men during the winter, and about 20 during the summer season, distributing about \$20,000 per year in wages, practically all the help is hired locally.

NORTH POWDER, Nov. 26.—J. M. Younes, who owns 520 acres on Wolf Creek, is one of the lucky ranchers in this valley this fall, having sold his barley at \$2.47 per hundred. This year he did not have to irrigate but averaged 68 bushels to the acre. His oats also ran about the same.

Mr. Younes specializes in Percherons, draft and farm horses and short horn cattle, also a few hogs. He rarely sells any grain, feeding it all to his stock, but this year \$2.47 per hundred tempted him to break his rule. Mr. Younes was one of the very few who receive this high price, it only holding up to this for a few days.

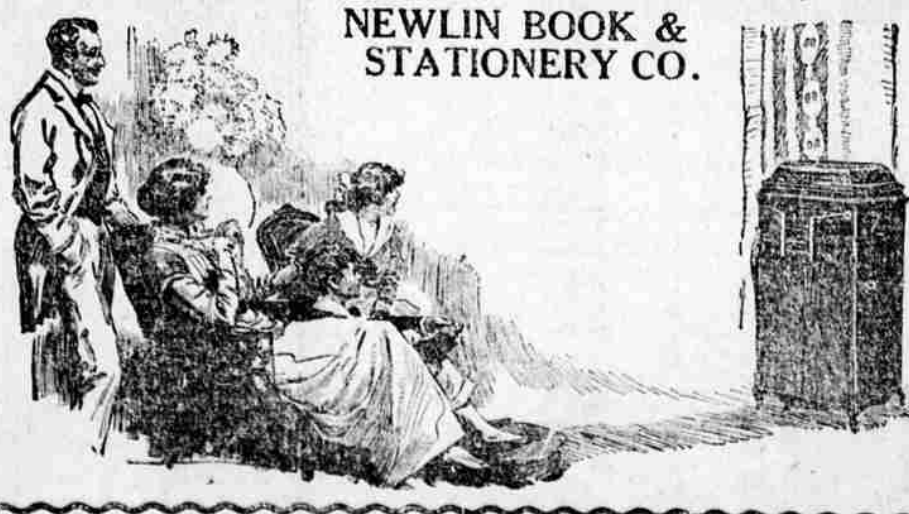
