WRESTLERS REJECTED BY U. S. ARMY DOCTORS

Thye and Taylor are Declared Unfit for Military Service.

The following clipping from a Portland paper may be of interest to the many friends and admirers of Ted Thye of Spokane who has wrestled here on two different occasions. In his appearance against Jim Noregaard on October 2nd his shoulder was dislocated and he was compelled to forfeit the match after giving one of the fastest and clearest exhibitions of wrestling ever seen here.

Spokane, Wash.—Wrestling was given a severe jolt by the examining physician at Camp Lewis when Ted Thye, local middleweight mat star, and Jack Taylor, former Spokane heavyweight, were turned down by the examining board as unfit for military service. They have returned to Spokane.

Taylor tried to get into the heavy artillery end of the soldiering game, while Thye was lined up with the infantry. Thye had been in the camp some time, in fact he had been raised to a corporal's standing and was in charge of a squad of recruits when he was called before the examining board a second time and notified that he was not physically fit for service.

PROSPEROUS; DIDN'T KNOW IT

Sherwood, a busy little community in the corner of Washington County, sixteen miles out from Portland, didn't realize its own importance until it took a traffic census and discovered that an average of over two hundred vehicles a day came into town and that an average of one carload a day of neighborhood products were shipped out. Of onions alone, one hundred and sixty-five carloads were shipped during the last twelve months. The community desires better roads to facilitate movement of existing traffic and bring a bigger tonnage into the city by the stimulation of production that comes from better roads.—Oregon Voter.
