MESSICK DAMAGE SUIT—SEALING CONCLUSION.

BAKER, Dec. 6. (Special.)—Taking testimony in the damage suit filed by ex-County Judge Messick closed yesterday afternoon. Mr. Rand then opened the argument, devoting the rest of the morning to reviewing his side of the case and painting Judge Messick as being persecuted.

In his forceful and eloquent manner, Mr. Rand threw himself into his subject. Mr. Rand took the position that the affidavits concerning Judge Messick's alleged improper relations with his ward, Glenn Record, were in themselves actionable and that if nothing more had been asserted outside the affidavits by the circulators still the contents of the affidavits were libelous and defamatory; that their direct effect was to deprive Judge Messick of public esteem and confidence and to injure him irreparably both as a citizen and lawyer and as the holder of an office of trust and confidence.

Judge Clifford for the defense was no less vigorous in his manner. He denied emphatically that the defendants were actuated by personal malice or sought ulterior purposes, claiming that their actions at all times were open and above board.

that Judge Messick was given an opportunity to refute all charges against him, and finding in this he was offered an opportunity to resign office, which he refused to do. The defense claimed that the words of the Baldwin affidavit were not and are not actionable in themselves because they do not charge the plaintiff with the commission of any crime but merely constitute an official statement, under oath by Mrs. Baldwin.

OFFICIAL WAR PICTURES AT THE STAR THEATRE.

Tomorrow, Saturday, the first official war pictures to be shown in La Grande will be presented at the Star Theatre for the one day only.

The three reel picture "In the Wake of the Huns" was used in Portland during the last Liberty loan drive by the committee and caused much interest. They were taken in the battle region after Von Hindenburg's "victorious retreat." The ruin and desolation in the Somme, the Oise, and on the Aisne are pictured in all their appalling tragedy. Shattered villages, blown up bridges, devastated orchards and every imaginable form of vandalism that may be inflicted upon more property are shown. Occasional peasants are seen among the ruins and this gives a human touch to the views. Armies on the march and big guns in action are also shown. The other reels are "With the Stars and Stripes in France," and show "our boys" at work and play.

In addition to these interesting pictures, the Musical Sheremans will entertain with their Hawaiian specialties.

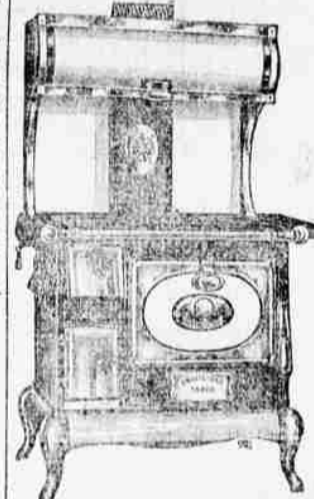
