Red Cross Notes From France

In one week in November the American Red Cross lines of communication canteens in France served approximately 80,000 soldiers. At one canteen a cup of coffee was served every ten seconds for a period of two hours. The pressure of work at times was very great.

At one of the American aviation training camps in France Miss Given Wilson with six other Americans, Red Cross canteen workers, has started a rest station that is giving excellent service to aviation students and members of the engineering corps in serving hot chocolate and sandwiches. One rainy day, in an hour and three-quarters, 416 men were served.

The surgical dressings department of the American Red Cross in France made and handled 183,988 surgical dressings of all kinds in October.

Work on some of the sections of the Bligny Hospital for Tubercular men, which will have 350 beds, was completed the first week in November. Four hundred patients in French tubercular hospitals in Paris have been cheered by gifts of food and games, and by visits from the American Red Cross visitors. Six delegates are acting as American Red Cross agents in aiding refugees in departments of France far from Paris and the Paris office is shipping clothing to workers all over France. Final arrangements have been made for use of a large building on the Avenue du Maine in Paris, which the Red Cross is equipping to house refugees.

The hog alley showed heavy receipts, most of which were pretty good quality of hogs. The top used went at 16.00 but the bulk of hogs crossed the scales at 15.65-15.90. We quote the following prices on hogs: Prime light, 15.65-15.80; prime heavy 15.70-16.00; pigs 13.75-15.00; bulk, 15.75.

PORTLAND MARKET LETTER

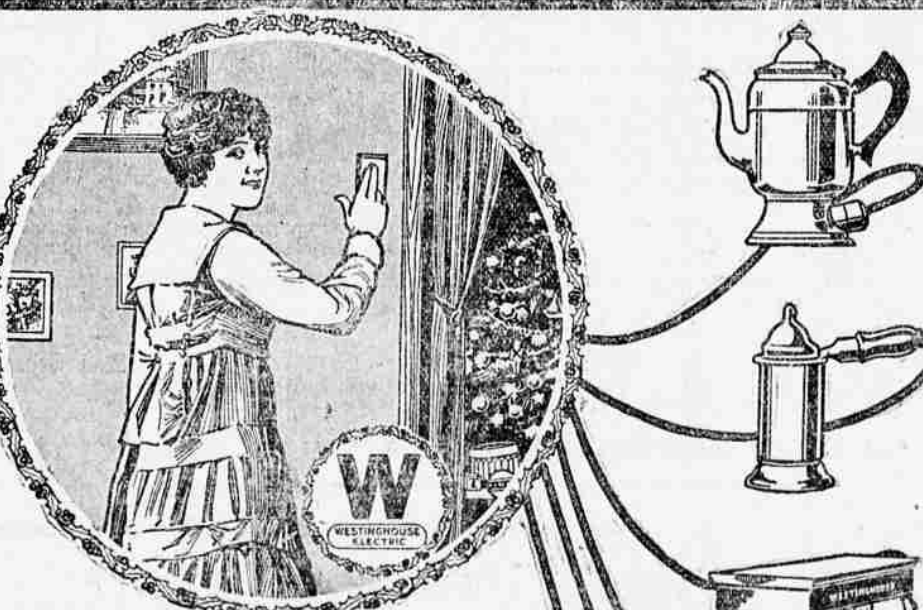
PORTLAND, Dec. 19.—As seemed to be the indication throughout the last week, the market Monday at the Portland Union Stock Yards opened with a fair supply and a satisfactory demand. The string of stock enter-

ing the yards for the early week's market extended up to about 900 cattle, 3200 hogs and 1800 sheep.

Amongst the cattle there was one load of pretty good steers that crossed the scales at 10 cents and two loads of good cows that changed hands at 7.60. The steers that went at 10 cents were not as good quality,
