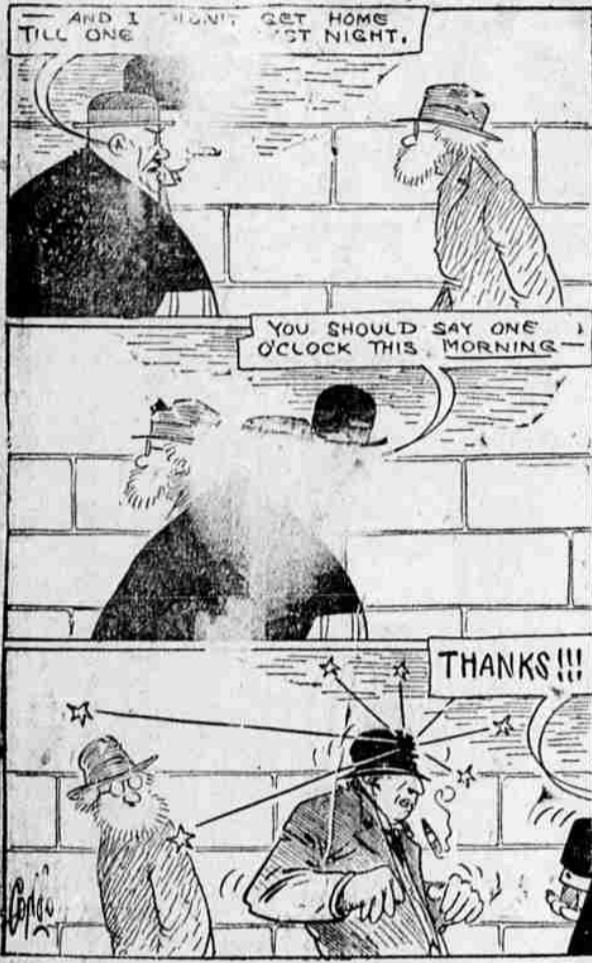

Houston, Secretary of Agriculture, makes the following statement regarding the purchase of 100,000 tons of Chilean nitrate for fertilizer use by farmers under the provision in the food control act which authorizes the President to procure nitrate of soda for this purpose and to supply it to farmers for cash at cost.
