

The La Grande Observer Will Publish a Special Morning Edition For Wallowa County

This Edition, Besides the News of La Grande and Union County, Will Carry a Special Morning Telegraphic News Report, Giving All The News of The World and Special Correspondence From The Towns of Wallowa County.



ANNOUNCEMENT

On account of its rapidly growing circulation and in answer to the many and repeated requests of its many subscribers in Wallowa County because of their desires to get the news of the world war and national news while it is still fresh, The La Grande Observer has determined to print a special morning edition to meet these demands.

The La Grande Evening Observer has now the most complete and modern newspaper plant in Eastern Oregon. It has at considerable expense installed a modern Web Perfecting Duplex Press, capable of printing 3500 complete newspapers an hour. It has two Linotype machines, capable of setting the news swiftly and in up-to-date typographic dress. It has a large staff of competent printers.

To meet the desires of its patrons in Wallowa County, The Observer management has decided to add to its already complete evening telegraphic news service, a morning telegraphic news report for a special Wallowa County edition, which will be delivered to its readers in Wallowa County on the day of publication. Besides it will print special Wallowa County correspondence from the various towns that it will serve.

The Observer will thus print morning telegraphic news:

Sixteen Hours Earlier News Than The Portland Evening Newspapers.

Thirty Four Hours Earlier News Than The Portland Morning Newspapers.

The La Grande Observer is the only daily newspaper with a telegraphic news service in Union and Wallowa Counties. It is fully alive to the needs of its territory, which it serves and intends to serve fully and completely.

Adding a morning telegraphic service for its Wallowa County readers is another step forward for The Observer.
