RAISE YOUR OWN PORK AND HELP WIN WAR FOR THE ALLIES



"Have you a pig?" is the newest slogan of war activity, that of producing more pigs for pork to help win the war. The many branches of government activity have been turned loose to boost the hog population. Community efforts seem likely to be centered almost as much on the hog as upon gardening and various plans will be followed. The outstanding plan, according to Charles O. Robinson in the "Live Stock Report" will make the pigs a neighborhood, municipal and regional issue. What already has been done in Manitoba will be generally done. "Ten thousand members in agricultural societies, 15,000 members of boys' and girls' clubs and 6,000 members of the home economic associations are enlisted in the tremendous effort Manitoba is putting forth to greatly increase hog production," the Hon. Valentine Winkler, Minister of Agriculture for the province, said during a conference on the live stock situation in Chicago. Uncle Sam may emulate the example of Canada where the governments are working with the agricultural colleges in encouraging the industry by placing buyers on the Winnipeg, Edmonton and Calgary markets to buy breeding stock to resell to farmers and small-town householders at cost. Every farmer in the province will raise at least one litter of pigs more this year than last and thousands of householders will produce their own pork and bacon, thus taking them out of the consumer class. The family pig has come into its own after a generation of desuetude.
