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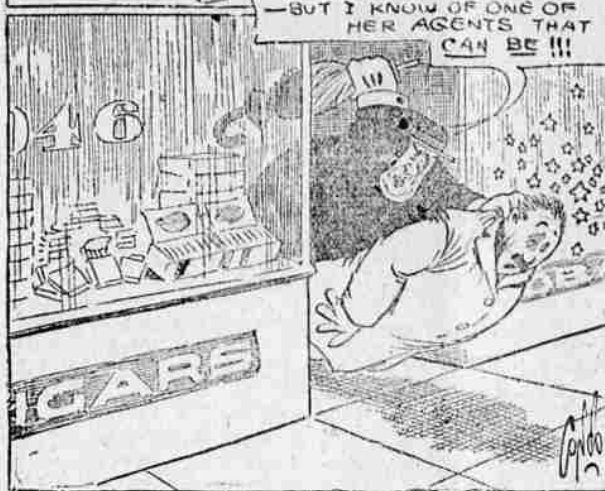

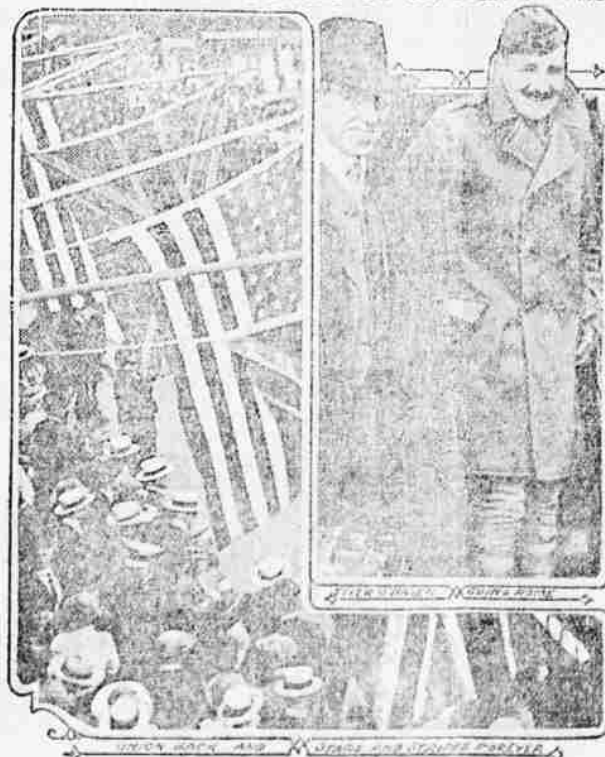
Returns From California—Miss Marie Brawling, who has been visiting in California for these months visited with her brother, H. L. Browning, here on her way home to Enterprise.

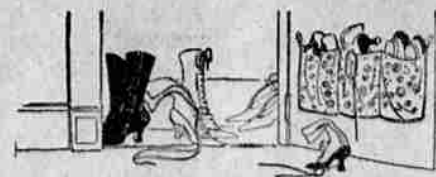
O'BRIEN'S DARING STIRS MEN TO FLOCK TO ROYAL FLIERS

IDAHO LOAFERS MUST WORK

(Associated Press.)

BOISE, Idaho, Feb. 12.—"When the nation is at war, no man's time is his own. It belongs to the government." With this statement the Idaho state council of defense has appealed to the people of the state to see that loafers and idlers, rich as well as poor, be put to some useful employment. "If there is no state law to reach this class which is not contributing to the nation's needs, the first act of the legislature, in the event it is called into special session, should be to place one on the statute books," says a statement issued by the council.

It recommends that the municipalities pass ordinances to meet the situation until the legislature convenes.
