PORTLAND MARKETS

February 15, 1918. General conditions at the Portland Union Stock Yards continue steady at the week's closing market, with light receipts in all departments except the sheep houses, where a total approximating 2000 constituted a fair shipment for a week-end market. There was no top stuff received in the cattle department, with feeders and stockers prevailing and rather a dull market in the canner and common classes. Buyers were present with the demand approximating the supply, and prices were not altered, although trading was somewhat slower today than it has been for the past ten days. The hog alleys showed moderate receipts of medium to fair quality, which crossed the scales at steady prices. The supply continues insufficient to meet the demand, even at the present high level of prices at which Portland continues to be the highest priced hog market in the country. Prices continue firm in the sheep department in all classes. The following quotations obtain throughout the market: CATTLE--Med. to choice steers, 10.35-11.50; good to medium steers, 9.35-10.35; common to good steers, 8.00-10.00; choice cows and heifers, 8.00-9.50; common to good cows and heifers, 6.75-8.15; canners, 4.25-6.25; bulls, 5.00-8.00; calves, 7.50-11.00; stockers and feeders, 6.50-9.50. HOGS--Prime light, 16.75-17.00; Prime heavy, 16.00-16.25; pigs, 14.50-15.50; bulk, 15.75. SHEEP--Western lambs, 15.00-15.50; Valley lambs, 14.50-15.00; yearlings, 13.00-13.50; wethers, 12.50-13.00; ewes, 9.00-11.00.

GIRLS HELP MAKE CARS

MANY NOW EMPLOYED IN BIG PACKARD FACTORY Most of New Workers Put in Carriage Department--They Prefer Aprons to Overalls. Nearly 1000 men having been called to the colors from among

the Packard Motor Car Company's employes, it has been necessary to introduce women workers into the factory, to maintain production of motor-carriages, together with an increased production of trucks in response to Government demand. In line with Packard thoroughness a school has been established to train women in upholstering, trimming and other work calling for skilled operatives. In numerous departments of the factory women are taking the place of men who have gone to the front or are in some way serving the Na-

tion. Most of the women employed are in the carriage division, as their natural ability can be utilized to better advantage in that department. Women are now making tops and curtains, doing all sorts of inspection work and handling various small chassis parts. A large number are operating drill presses and automatic screw machines. Clerical work, such as keeping time cards and doing the routine office work of the various factory departments, is now largely done by women.
