WHEAT FOR DUCK BAIT. 30,000 Pounds of It Owned by Wealthy Men Seized. Thirty thousand pounds of wheat belonging to "wealthy men of Portland, Seattle and other places" has been seized by agents of the federal food administration, according to announcement made by W. K. Newell, acting food administrator for Oregon. The wheat was found in storehouses on game preserves along the Columbia river, and was being used to bait wild ducks. No one would give the names of the owners.
