**TO ALL PATRIOTIC CITIZENS:**

The La Grande Chapter of the Red Cross is compelled to make another appeal to the patriotic citizens of this community. The funds of the Chapter are inadequate to the demands made upon it for the purchase of material and supplies which it is supposed to furnish.

At the recent time the Chapter finds itself in debt about \$1,000, having expended since April 16, 1917, to April 1, 1918, \$24,347.38. Their indebtedness at this time in excess of their assets is \$1,017.59.

In order to hold the chapter's charter and continue the good work which is now more necessary and essential than ever before in the history of the war, the chapter has found that it will have to receive a regular monthly income amounting to from one to two thousand dollars and to this end

**STATE CONVENTION OF SUNDAY SCHOOL WORKERS**

The coming state Sunday school convention that begins in La Grande next Monday will bring not only a large number of enthusiastic Sunday school workers from Eastern Oregon, but also several speakers of national reputation.

The international representative, Rev. E. W. Halpenay, was for many years the general secretary of Ontario, Canada, where he was recognized as one of the strong, able men of the Dominion. He has very recently come to the International staff in Chicago.

Mr. E. C. Knapp, of Washington, secretary of the Inland Empire Association, will be on the program. He has been here before and has a host of friends in this section. He is now giving half his time to the Plymouth Congregational church of Seattle, where he is building up one of the great schools of the United States. His Sunday school activities reach from the Atlantic to the Pacific Coast and he is rated as one of the most practical workers in the Sunday school field.

Mrs. L. M. Ormsby, of Boise, is the general secretary for Idaho. She will add greatly to the program. Mrs. M. A. Danenbover, of Portland, who has headed so successfully the work in this state the past year, will also be present.

President Levi Pennington, of Pacific college, is recognized as one of the great Christian educators of Oregon and his part in the program will be one of its most attractive features.

Dr. J. D. Springston, of Portland, and Rev. John H. Matthews, of Seattle, will bring practical messages. Both are prominent Sunday school men as well as class students of psychology and Christ-

ian education. Rev. R. E. Carnell, pastor of the M. E. Church at Pendleton, and several other prominent state speakers are among those who will be present and who have been assigned places on the program.

It is expected that La Grande will give the speakers and the delegates to this convention a cordial reception. Great benefit to the Sunday schools and churches are expected to come as a result of the convention, which is to begin Monday and continue two days.
