FORESTRY IS WOMAN'S PART

GIRLS GO DEEP INTO ISOLATION TO HELP UNCLE SAM.

Prove To Be Extremely Valuable In Help They Furnish To The Forestry Department.

SAN FRANCISCO, August 24.—Perched atop lofty peaks in national parks of northern California two girls are braving the lonely and often dangerous life in these isolated districts to serve as lookouts for the United States forest service. Miss Hollie M. Daggert, daughter of John Daggert, formerly lieutenant governor of California and at one time superintendent of the United States mint at San Francisco, and Miss Mollie Ingoldsbey, of Los Angeles are two of only three women employed in the United States as forest look-outs.

This is Miss Daggert's fifth season as lookout at the Eddy's gulch station, near Sawyer's bar, Blakely county. She was born and reared in the shadow of the mountains where she now keeps watch promptness and effectiveness of the government's fire fighting forces. She was the first woman lookout employed in this country.

Miss Daggert's cabin is filled with skins and furs that evidence her skill as a trapper and hunter and Acting Forest Ranger Lewis Carroll reports that she has rendered valuable assistance to the United States biological survey in its campaign against predatory animals. Miss Daggert's sister, Miss Leslie Daggert, who lives at the residence, the White House, one of the shrines of the district and Miss May Ahlgren are reported to have rendered valuable assistance in July by riding horseback over the district and recruiting an emergency fire fighting crew when all men usually available were already combating the flames.

Miss Ingoldsbey's post is a tiny government observatory at an elevation of 7,245 feet on the very summit of Mount Hough in the Ulnamas national forest. Here with her sister she lives, obtaining her supplies with those packed in from time to time from Taylorville, in northern Plumas county, by mining operators. Miss Ingoldsbey is city bred and 23 years old.

"This is my ideal of a fine way to pass a delightful summer, while at the same time doing worthwhile work," Miss Ingoldsbey wrote to the forestry office here. "And most important of all it releases one more man for active service."

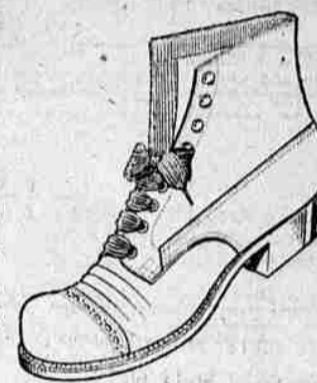
