### WHOLESALE PEOPLE EXPECT PLAN TO TERMINATE

This View is Endorsed by Southern Whole Sale Grocers Association

Mr. G. L. Larison, manager of the La Grande Grocery company, expects soon to see his line of goods become more stabilized than at present with the final proclamation of peace. This view is also supported by the Southern Wholesale Grocers Association, which has put out a circular in which the following references to this subject are made:

In referring to the fact that the Food Administration would, under the provisions of the law which created it, be discontinued when peace is proclaimed by the President, Mr. Hoover has further stated that he does not expect to see its renewal.

He further states, "I look now for a turn of American food trades toward conservative and safe business." Relying upon Mr. Hoover's statements, and, governed by the consensus of opinions unofficially expressed here in official circles, we are prepared at this time to express to you the opinion that with the President's Proclamation of Peace, government regulation and control of food distribution will automatically come to a stop. A number of persons interviewed express substantially the same opinion—one opinion is to the effect that "Paternalism is undesirable from the very moment it ceases to be a necessity." Another opinion expressed is "the Food Administration was necessary during the period of War but NOT after peace is declared."

The general feeling here is that the American people can be trusted to do their duty as regards food conservation in the interest of the nation and the world, and that federal domination in the matter is both undesirable and unnecessary.

Summed up, we repeat, that at this moment there is every reason to believe that with the Proclamation of Peace, not only the Food Administration, but any form of federal control of food distribution will cease.

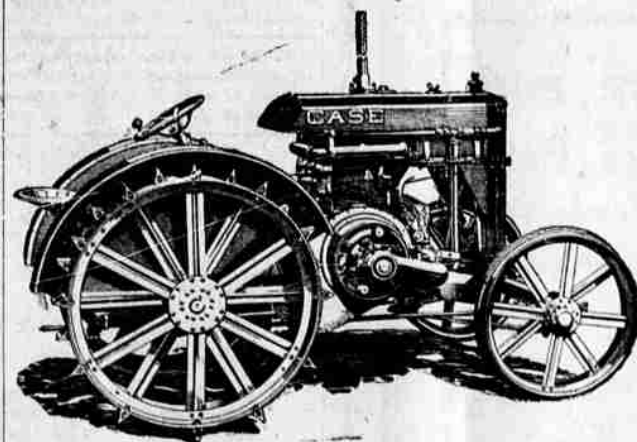
