The disappointment of our boys who have not been called into actual combat with the Hun is voiced in a letter received by Judge and Mrs. Knowles from their son, Everett. He says: "Our latest song down here is 'Take Your Service Flag out of the Window—your Boy is only in Panama.'"

Everett was one of the first boys to enlist but has happened to be on one of the ships kept for patrol on our borders, and is now in the Panama zone. He sarcastically remarks that it is very exciting to travel back and forth from one busy to another. He is at present on the U. S. Submarine Chaser 281.

From France.
Excerpts from other letters are as follows:
"As I write the guns are putting on a good barrage with a few arguments the square heads can understand."

"Major Graham paid us a visit yesterday. His outfit is located not far from here. He is now the big smoke—medically—of the anglers. It's a good job, all right. The barrage continues, but so far I have not heard a shell coming this way. There is a French battery just behind our tent. It sure tears up the atmosphere when it cuts loose. It isn't more than a hundred yards away, but at that I slept through its noise last night."

"This afternoon as I was out on a hill getting some blackberries for supper a Hun aviator came over and shot down a balloon not a quarter of a mile away. He then flew up and banked about a hundred yards above me. If I had only had a gun it would have been like shooting ducks, but as it was I could only get behind a tree out of the way of the anti-aircraft guns and admire his nerve. Six planes pumped him and brought him down but he sure had nerve."
