Finland Bonfires.
Originally the Finlanders were fire worshippers, and to this fact, doubtless, may be traced the custom, never neglected at midsummer and other seasons, of lighting on the hills bonfires, around which the country folk dance, while they join their voices in musical choruses. 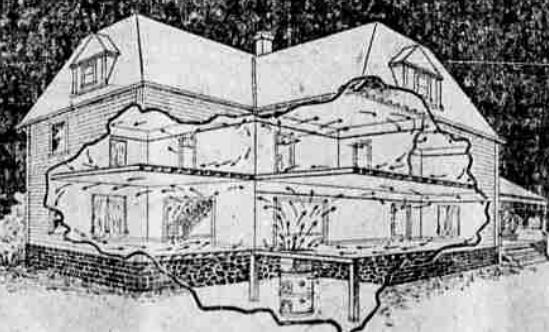

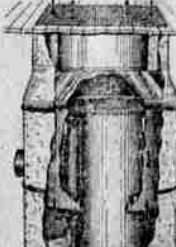
