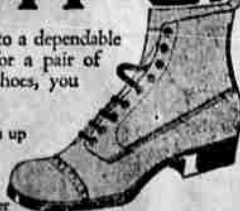

CITY MANAGER'S WEEKLY REPORT

ONE FIRE, SEVEN ARRESTS REPORTED FOR THE PAST WEEK.

The Fire chiefs report one fire for the week ending November 25. This was the John Ladd house on Ash avenue. Thirteen volunteers responded at a total cost to the city of \$14.50. Insurance \$800.00. Estimated loss, \$600.00.

The chief of police reports seven arrests for the week ending November 24: Disorderly conduct, 4. Dunks, 3. Number convicted, 5. Number paroled, 2. Amount of fines collected, \$85.00. Stock impounded, 1. Fines from pound, \$1.75.

The foreman of the Street Manager Water Department reports a total expenditure for labor for the week of \$120.00. Twenty-four dollars is charged to the water department and ninety-six to the street department. The usual street cleaning, side and cross walk repairing and gravel hauling was done. The water department installed five new meters and replaced two which had developed leaks. The old crossing lumber has been gathered up and delivered to the pound where it can be sawed and used for fuel. The water has been turned off at the park and the service there drained.
