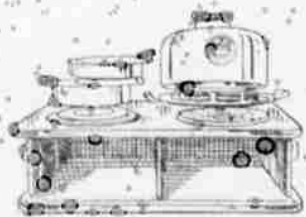

RIGHT SLEW IN CAPLES

Portland Market Shows Drop With Trading Slow.

PORTLAND, Dec. 5—With 1700 head of cattle on the market at North Portland today the trading is slow with an undoubted weakness while steers are selling up to the quoted price according to quality. The cow market shows a decline of fifty to seventy-five cents. Quotations are: Prime steers \$11.50 to \$12.50; good to choice steers \$9.50 to \$11.50; medium to good steers \$8.50 to \$10.50; fair to medium steers \$7.50 to \$9.50; choice cows and heifers \$7.75 to \$8.50; medium to good cows and heifers \$6 to \$7; fair to medium cows and heifers \$5 to \$6; canners \$3 to \$4; bulls \$5 to \$7; calves \$9 to \$12; stockers and feeders \$6 to \$8.

Approximately 2400 head came forward over Sunday. The market is generally steady with the sheep holding around \$16.75 to \$18.25. Quotations are: prime mixed \$16.50 to \$16.85; medium mixed \$14.50 to \$16.00; rough heavy \$14.50 to \$16.50; plus \$24 to \$35; bulk \$16.50 to \$16.75.

750 sheep and lambs counted in the sheep division over Sunday and are finding ready sales at steady prices. Quotations are: Prime lambs \$22 to \$25; fair to medium lambs \$9 to \$11; yearlings \$10 to \$11; wethers \$9 to \$10; ewes \$6 to \$8.
