CHANGE IN AREA FOREST RESERVE

LARGE TRACT IN OREGON NATIONAL FOREST CUT OUT

60,000 Acres, of Little Value, and Mostly Privately Owned, is Eliminated from Reserve

WASHINGTON, Dec. 21.—The president on November 27, signed a proclamation eliminating approximately 46,029 acres from the Deschutes National Forest, Oregon. The main area affected comprises a tract about 7 miles square, situated near the present southwestern corner of the forest. This tract is practically a solid body of privately owned land, which is now alienated as the result of consolidation of forest lands through the means of land exchange between the government and certain private land owners. Nearly 90 per cent of all the lands excluded are privately owned and only about 4,500 acres are government lands. These areas are of little value for national forest purposes, and at the same time possess but slight agricultural possibilities.

The president's proclamation results from recommendations submitted by the secretary of agriculture.
