SITE FOR SHIPYARD SOUGHT

MARSHFIELD, Jan. 17.—The Swedish-Finn company of Marshfield, which raised \$75,000 in an hour for establishment of a shipyard, was unable to negotiate a lease of either the Coos Bay Shipbuilding company plant or that of Kruse & Banks, two of its promoters now are inspecting other possible sites for the new yard. Those associated in the venture are all expert shipbuilders. They number probably 60 per cent of the shipworkers on Coos Bay.

One site investigated was on the Southern Oregon company holdings at Empire, where there is fine water front and available launching facilities. This site is handicapped, however, by lack of a convenient saw-mill.

The company believes there is sufficient demand for coasting lumber schooners to keep a new yard in operation for years. The company would operate on a co-operative basis and the yard would be strictly a union plant.

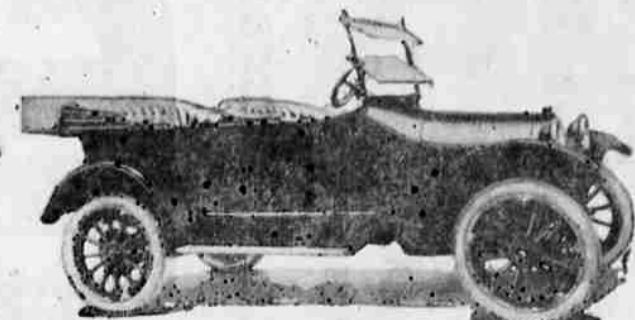
