Among the Franklin sayings that have urged thrift since the early days of the republic are the following:

"If you would be wealthy think of saving as well as getting."  
"Save and have."  
"Look before, or you'll find yourself behind."  
"All things are cheap to the sinner, dear to the wasteful."  
"Reveries of small expenses; a small leak will sink a great ship."  
"Gain may be temporary and momentary, but expense is constant and certain."  
"It is easier to suppress the first desire than to satisfy all that follow it."

RED CROSS PROVIDES VALUABLE INSTITUTION.

Citizens Support New Enterprise—Community Fund Will Be Used to Purchase Literature.

IMBLER, Jan. 20.—(Special)—The citizens of Imbler gathered in the Red Cross room Friday evening for the purpose of completing the movement that had already been started to form a public reading room in the rooms previously occupied by the Red Cross society. The purpose of this reading room is to have some place for the men and boys of all ages to go and spend their evenings reading good magazines or playing innocent games. The meeting was called to order by the chairman of the Red Cross, Miss Anna Brooks. The proposition of how much time should be used came up and it was decided to let the men and boys have most of the time, and one day, which will be decided on later, for the ladies. The Red Cross society is to pay rent, light, janitor and fuel expenses. The community funds will be used to purchase reading material and sports. A number of magazines have been subscribed for, namely: Popular Mechanics, Scientific American, Literary Digest, Oregon Daily Journal, Life, Saturday Evening Post, Youth Companion, National Geographic, Atlantic Monthly, Elgin Recorder, La Grande Daily Observer, Oregon Voter.

These papers will be found on the tables at all times. The following rules were adopted: (1) No swearing or rough talking allowed. (2) Regular playing cards and "pat" shall not be used. (3) Closing hours shall be 10 o'clock p. m. (4) Books and magazines shall not be taken from the room. (5) Executive committee of Red Cross shall have power to set days for ladies. (6) Doors open from 10 to 12 a. m., 2 to 5 and from 7 to 10 every evening. K. E. Hurley has been selected

chairman of the reading room committee.

### SERBIA AT PEACE

Statement Issued Says Perfect Order Prevails in Montenegro.

WASHINGTON, Jan. 20.—The Serbian legation has issued a statement denying that Montenegrins have revolted against Serbian troops occupying Montenegro. It was said that a few days ago said perfect order prevailed throughout the little country. The Montenegrin legation announced Friday night that it had been

informed that some 20,000 insurgents in Montenegro had revolted against the Serbian forces and had succeeded in occupying several towns.

### RECORD PRICE PAID FOR COOS BAY LAND

MARSHFIELD, Ore., Jan. 20.—A record price for Coos Bay dairy lands was paid by Charles Mahaffey, a North Coos river rancher, for twelve and a half acres of bottom land adjoining his former holdings. Mr. Mahaffey

purchased twenty-three acres from a neighbor and in the deal twelve and a half acres of the richest land were figured at \$600 each.

The prices of dairy lands on Coos river cannot be definitely averaged, since none of the ranchers in late years have been disposed to sell and no transfers have been recorded. In the past two years dairymen have received very high rates for their milk and manufactured products and thus find no reason for selling their land.
