### NORTH POWDER OUTFIT COMES HERE FOR GAME WITH HIGH SCHOOL TONIGHT.

The La Grande high school basketball team, playing their first game of the season at Union Saturday night, surprised even their coach by slipping enough shots through the basket to win by the good score of 43 to 19. The game was fast from the first whistle and with the exception of a few minutes in the second half the Union team was on the defensive throughout the game.

"Mose" Lyman, captain of the local team, was high point getter, scoring 19 points. Ledbetter and Kivette at forwards broke even with 8 points apiece, while Wright, at guard, made three baskets for 6 points. Ash, at the other guard, shot the first basket of the game for a score of two. Proctor and Stoddard went into the game during the last five minutes, but did not score. The team, which is composed of only one member of last year's championship squad, displayed some team work which characterized the play of the 1917-1918 team, and while not composed of any such stars as Taylor, Garrity, Ash and McDonald, this year's squad plays a good game and perhaps is as strong as the average basketball team representing the local high school during the past few years.

The North Powder town team will play in the local gym tonight and while nothing is known of their ability, a good game is promised, nevertheless. This and the return game with Union perhaps will be the only ones on the local floor this season.
