Two Steamships Reached New York
Today With Large List of Re-

NEW YORK, March 7.—With 2200
troops, who are members of various
aero squadrons the steamship Meach
arrived from St. Nazaire today.

St. Nazaire on the Magnolia, including
three officers and one hundred and
sixty men from the 316th trench mortar
battery of the 91st division and na-
tional army troops from the Pacific

WOMAN GIVES DOLLAR-A-YEAR HOSPITAL TO BLIND SOLDIERS

AMIR'S SON TAKES CHARGE

Brother of Assassinated Ruler of
Afghanistan Yields Office.

LONDON, March 5.—Sardar Aman-
ulla Khan, third son of the late amir
of Afghanistan, who was assassinated
February 29, has declared himself amir
and assumed the reins of government
at Kabul, the capital, according to an
announcement by the Indian office.
Nasrullah Khan, the brother of the
late amir, who previously had claimed
the succession, it is said, now has
made submission to Sardar Amanulla.
Amanulla Khan was born June 1,
1892.

CAPTAIN SHOT BY SEAMAN

Master of American Schooner Jer-
emiah Smith Killed.

BARBADOS, B. W. I., March 5.—
Robert Lear, a seaman on the Amer-
ican schooner Jeremiah Smith, shot
and killed Captain Black of the
schooner and wounded Mate Gray
while the schooner lay in port here.
The reason for his act is not known.

The schooner Jeremiah Smith left
Boston on December 10 for the coast
of South America. The schooner
measures 409 tons and is owned at
New Haven.
