CHIEF OF POLICE WILL SHOW SAFETY FIRST FILM SOON

The toll of life and limb taken by automobiles in recent years has led to a general crusade against carelessness on the part of both drivers and pedestrians.

Draconic laws governing the use of streets and highways have reduced accidents considerably in some sections, but public authorities admit they will be powerless to do much without the active backing of public sentiment and the co-operation of the people.

H. S. Firestone, president of the Firestone Tire & Rubber Company has undertaken to conduct a campaign of education on a vast scale using a motion picture made by the Universal Film Mfg. Co., called "Careless America."

Chief of Police Christianson says: "The man on foot has a responsibility as well as the vehicle driver. While the former has the right of way, he is expected to use due caution and discretion. It will go hard with any policeman who fails to perform his duty in suppressing reckless and criminal speeding on the streets and highways. Never in the history of mankind was human life as precious as today. The theatre owners and the newspaper of La Grande are co-operating with me to give all publicity possible to the motion picture which I have secured from the Universal Film Manufacturing Company. This will appear in local theatres on dates in April, to be announced soon."

Every man, woman and child must see this picture and learn the valuable lessons it teaches. The present generation will make the world safe for democracy. The next will guide its destiny. Our duty is to help make our streets safe that they may live."

Here are some specific rules that I wish every person in our community would clip out and keep before them:

DON'T cross the street between the blocks. Remember, vehicles have just as much right to the road as you have.

NEVER carry on a conversation while crossing a street. NEVER try to read while crossing a street. NEVER hold an open umbrella so you cannot see approaching traffic.

NEVER alight from a moving car. Wait for it to stop. ALWAYS observe the movement of traffic when alighting, before crossing to the walk.

WARN children not to hitch on cars or vehicles; or play or skate in the path of traffic.

If you drive a vehicle learn the traffic rules of the particular places you travel through.

REMEMBER, the pedestrian has just as much right to the road as you have.

DON'T disregard danger signals. They are put up for YOUR protection.

Carry a warning signal of some kind. AND USE IT.

STOP before you cross railway tracks.

EXAMINE your brakes and steering gear frequently.

If you must drink to excess, don't drive. If you see a drunken driver have him arrested, for your own safety and his.

SPENDING will only get you to one place quicker—the grave.

Lighting your head and tail lamps at dusk may prolong your life.

When the streets are wet or icy, be sure your tires will not skid. This caution protects you from possible imprisonment, injury or death.

NEVER attempt to run a vehicle until you are entirely familiar with its operation and hold a license giving you the right.

If for some unavoidable reason,

you happen to run down some one DON'T run away. If you do you become a hunted murderer and it goes very hard for you when you're caught—and you will be caught!

GUSTAVO WINS IN FAST BOUT

Last night at the Star Theatre before a well-filled house of lovers of clean sport, Ad. Gustavo, to a very great extent, sprung a surprise and defeated Eddie O'Connell in their wrestling match, securing two falls out of three, after one of the prettiest exhibitions put off in this city.

Gustavo sprung a surprise because by a majority it was figured that Eddie was next to unbeatable by any man so near his own weight. But the dark-skinned Argentine athlete demonstrated to the satisfaction of everyone present that his knowledge of the mat game, backed up by unusual strength for a middleweight, makes him a dangerous man for any wrestler to take on.

O'Connell secured the first fall after five and one-half minutes of clever work, by what is known to the wrestling game as a flying mare. When the men again came to the mat after the intermission, both men settled down to a pretty and scientific exhibition of wrestling as one could ask for. During this bout, O'Connell fastened practically every hold known to modern wrestlers on his opponent, only to have them broken by Gustavo. After 35 minutes of terrific wrestling Gustavo succeeded in putting a combination leg and toe-hold on the Portland man, which he was unable to break, and the fall went to the Argentine champion. The third fall was secured in the same way, practically the same hold being used and O'Connell was forced to acknowledge defeat after a trifle over one minute's work in the third bout.

Ray McCarroll refereed the main event to the satisfaction of spectators and principals. A really good-sized crowd was in attendance, including many women, and all were rewarded by an exceptional exhibition by two men who rank among the best in the mat game. Everything was handled according to a well-arranged schedule and no kick is coming from any angle.

The first preliminary was between Ainsworth and Smith and resulted in a draw, neither man being able to secure a fall, and the same was the case in the ten-minute exhibition between Pat Foley and McCarroll. These two huskies went at each other for the time limit, but no decided advantage was noticeable. Both preliminaries were above the average, as was the main event. 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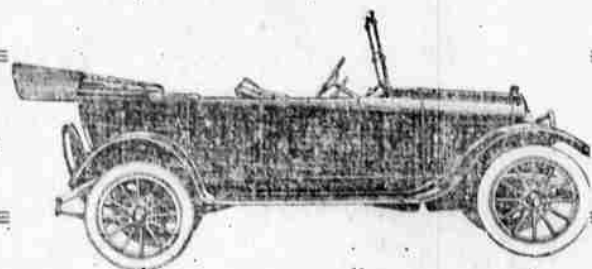
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
