When Robert H. Higgins great novel, "Bella Donna," was published several years ago, it created an immense literary sensation. It was dramatized and in it Alla Nazimova, the distinguished Russian actress, won her first American success, and an even greater success than she had achieved in the Ibsen roles which made her famous.

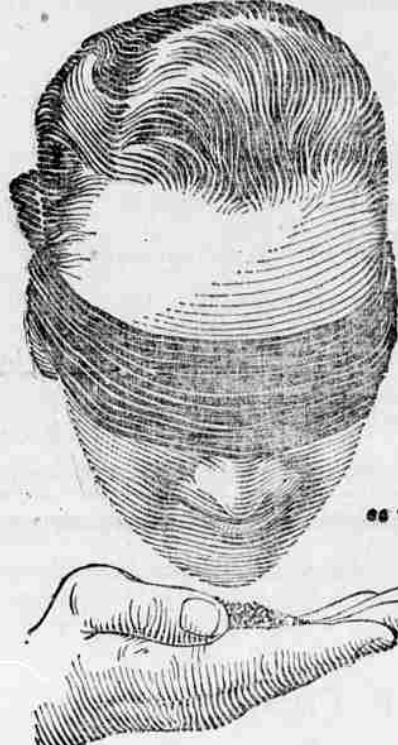
