

COUNTY QUOTAS DETERMINED FROM BANK RESOURCES

Quotas for the counties in Oregon in the Victory loan were determined by the federal reserve bank of the twelfth district at San Francisco. The basis for the quota is the average bank resources of each Oregon county for June and December, 1918.

There is a mistake in the belief in some localities that the various quotas have been juggled. There is no justification for any such idea. The figures from the federal reserve bank are supplied by John L. Etheridge, state director of organization.
