## SHORTHORN SALE COMES ON MAY 1

(Continued from Page 1)

To this part of Oregon worth more than passing notice. It means that from year to year an increasing number of men will be breeding registered Shorthorns in this part of the state and this, in turn, means that buyers will come for long distances to Union and adjoining counties to buy the best bred animals of the breed because of the opportunity presented of getting them in large numbers and the choice of many different herds. It means sale receipts that average two or three times more per head than has been received in past years for scrub or grade cattle.

The holding of this sale at La Grande also means little expense and little loss of time to those who attend and also the minimum expense in taking home stock bought.

The animals consigned are not only largely bred in Oregon, but their sires represent the most popular blood lines of the breed. The pedigrees bear for first sires such noted bulls as Graiglelea Stamp, a son of Wapato, bred by Frank Brown of Carlton, Ore., the western representative of the American Shorthorn Breeders' association and president of the Pacific International Live Stock exposition; and Chancellor, a son of Prince Violet 3d, bred by A. Chalmers, Forest Grove, Ore., from whose farm has gone foundation animals for so many grand herds of the breed in the west. Challenge Plate 3d, the famous bull at W. J. Townley of Union, Ore., bred at one of the great sales held in Canada. Baron Linwood 266th, a bull bred by W. J. Townley; Golden Gem Prince Superior, bulls bred by J. McCroskey & Son, Sprague, Wa. Victory, one of the good bulls bred by A. D. Dunn's Dunbro Farm over Washington. Starlight and R. Duke, sons of Radiator, an A. D. D. bull by Radiance. A Double Bull—Carrie's Minority, one of the good bulls bred by J. B. Cornett.

The men named above as breeders of the sires of offerings in the La Grande sale are those who have long been in the business of breeding Shorthorn cattle here in the northwest and from their herds have come the exhibitors at the fairs and big stock shows that won championships and that topped the sales. These names all carry value with them in Shorthorn lines wherever they may be found. Animals of this kind of breeding represent an exceptional opportunity to improve a herd of range cattle or to build up a registered herd.

Those who are familiar with the animals consigned state that the individuality of the bulls, cows and heifers is of a high character. Big rugged, healthy bulls of masculine type, just the kind that are needed on the range herds, will be found in the sale ring at La Grande.

Thursday, May 1, is the date set for the sale and this place will, according to reports, be represented by a large delegation of breeders.

## WOMEN RECOGNIZED

### Barriers to Legal Profession in Great Britain to Be Removed.

LONDON. (Correspondence of the Associated Press)—The House of Lords having passed the second reading of Lord Buckmaster's bill letting down the bars of the legal profession to women, the indications are that the measure will become a law during the present parliamentary session.

One by one, as a veteran observer of the struggle for women's rights point out, all the old sex barriers are tumbling down. It was strange, he says, to hear the government's blessing of this bill pronounced by the Lord Chancellor who, as Sir F. E. Smith, was one of the chief opponents of women's suffrage when he was a member of the House of Commons.

The work performed by women during the war, the Lord Chancellor explained, in vindicating his former opposition, had profoundly altered matters. "I may say," he continued, "that under the changed circumstances of the time the government welcomes this proposal, and that it is their hope that they may be able to give it such assistance as will render its passing into law highly probable."

The bill confers upon women the right of qualifying either as solicitors or barristers. It does not extend, however, to Scotland or Ireland.
