ITALY MUST MAKE FIRST MOVE IS VIEW IN PARIS

Peace Conference Circles See Little Material Change in Situation; Expect Italians to Return.

PARIS, May 2.—In spite of the optimistic views of the French press on the effect of Premier Orlando's talk to the Italian parliament, there were no indications in peace conference circles Wednesday of any feeling that the situation had altered materially. The temperate tone of the Italian premier's address was commented on favorably, but on the part of the council of three there were no signs of yielding from the previous position as was suggested in dispatches from Rome.

If the Italians expect some proposal from Paris, they will find no response. It is said here that no proposals will be made and that the next move rests with Italy. In conference circles it is believed that the Italian delegates will soon return.

Meanwhile the work of the conference is proceeding uninterrupted toward the signing of the peace treaty
