## COMMANDER ACCLIMATED

General Richardson, at Archangel, former Resident of Alaska.

SEWARD, Alaska, April 10.—(By Mail.)—Arctic winter weather at northern Russia, probably will not bother Brigadier General W. P. Richardson, commander of the American forces at Archangel, for the general is a pioneer Alaska "sourdoogh" of about twenty years residence and service in this northern territory.

As a lieutenant, not long out of West Point, Richardson came to Alaska first with the gold stampedeers of 1898. With a Captain Ray he was stationed on the Yukon River top reserve order. Later he was promoted to Captain and selected the site of the present day army posts of Fort Davis, near Nome, Fort Gibbon, at Tanana, Fort Egbert, at Eagle, and Fort William H. Seward, at Haines.

When Richardson became major he was head of the Alaska Road commission and directed the work of laying out roads and trails in all parts of the territory. "Richardson's Highway" across the Alaska mountains from Cordova to Fairbanks, bears his name. Later while still in Alaska, he became lieutenant-colonel, colonel and finally brigadier general. All of his promotions came for service in the north.

In November, 1917, General Richardson was assigned to command the depot brigade at Camp Lee, Petersburg. In March, 1918, as commander of a brigade, he went to France. Recently he was selected for service in Northern Russia.
