There is one in the city, however, Princess Rahme Haider, member of the ancient royal house of Syria, an author, dramatist and lecturer.

Tomorrow (Tuesday) evening, at 8:15 o'clock, Princess Rahme will appear at the Presbyterian church in this city and will give her own interpretation of "Naaman, the Leper," based on the old Bible story. This has been dramatized by Princess Rahme and will be given in scenes in costumes. The historical facts of the healing of leprosy of the great Syrian captain and his conversion to the faith of the Israelites, have been closely adhered to throughout the play.

Loving her people and her home with all her heart the Princess has toured several lecture and chautauqua platforms, telling of the inner life of her people. She was born at Baalbek, on the lower slopes of Mount Lebanon. She represents the pure Semitic race and has all the warmth of soul and poetry of her people, upon which has been superimposed the education afforded by American colleges at Beirut and Sidon—later expanded by studies at colleges in this country. Princess Haider will wear her royal robes of Damascus blue satin, embroidered with gold and jewels, hand made by girls of Damascus, after the style of her noble ancestors.

Miss Lucille Burgess, traveling companion of Princess Rahme, will present the weird Oriental music in native airs and words.

CONSTRUCTION GREATLY REDUCED BY WAR

ANCHORAGE, Alaska. (Correspondence of The Associated Press)—From a force of 2,500 workers before the United States entered the war, the number of employees employed on the Anchorage division of the government railroad have dwindled to 822.

The present small force is due to failure of an appropriation for the railroad by the last congress. No new construction work can be undertaken.
