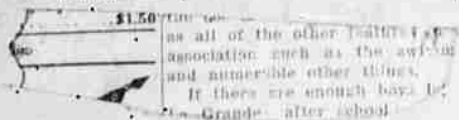

CITY MANAGER MAKES REPORT

I have to report for the week ending May 21:

The usual routine work by the street force, flushing the paved streets and cleaning gutters. In addition to this, one day was devoted to making preparations for the welcome of returned service men and half day to remove bags, stands, seats, etc. Several loads of gravel were used in filling approaches to cross walks and holes on C avenue and other streets.

The water force repaired the drinking fountain at the post office, made one tap at 1403 Second street, installed new meter at 2806 Spruce street, made a number of turn-ons and turn-offs and some minor repairs. The total expenditures for the week for labor in the water department were \$10.00, and in the street department \$112.57.

The fire department was called Sunday, May 18, to 1894 Third street for fire caused by burning flue. The call came in by phone to the police station. Box 21 was turned in and as there was no one at the box to direct the men to the fire house, time was lost in getting water on the fire. In this connection I would suggest that parties turning in fire alarm be careful to use the fire station number 759 or nearest fire box and have some one on the street to direct the firemen to the fire so no time will be lost. This is very important as every minute means much in getting action on a fire. The loss at this fire was \$454.50 on the roof and some on ceiling at house not yet repaired. Twelve volunteers responded to the call.

The police department reports four arrests for the week, one for apprehension of party from outside town, one for drunkenness and two for traffic violations. This is a good record for the week considering the large number of people in attendance at the celebration and the tendency on such occasions to overstep the bounds of propriety.

The recorder reports paid fees collected \$2.60; licenses issued for merry-go-round, rooming house, hotel and taxi, and five building permits, and thirty-three warrants

amounting to \$1,005.77. In comparing building permits issued this year with last year I find that the record shows for the same period: 1918, 7; 1919, 33, a very significant increase indicating confidence of our people in the city and its turn of prosperous times.

As suggested at the last meeting of the commission I have prepared a statement of cash on hand, with estimates of probable receipts, disbursements necessary to October 1, and suggested use of remaining funds. This statement does not include the Beaver Creek pipe line sinking fund except part as indicated. This fund is invested in other securities most of which can be converted into cash in time to redeem the bonds as they mature.
