## One Advantage of the Light Weight Franklin Is Officially Recognized

Nebraska has just been added to the list of states which have given official recognition to the part scientific light weight plays in correct automobile manufacture, according to notification received by the Franklin Automobile Company of Syracuse, New York.

Following, by a few weeks only, similar action taken by Canadian and Wyoming, the decision of the 1913 legislature at Lincoln, Neb., to tax automobiles entirely on the weight, again demonstrates the growing tendency to take advantage of a simple scientific principle. Nebraska's drastic change in its motor vehicle laws is already being worked out practically by the registering of all automobiles according to actual weight. Enforcement of the law has been delegated to the State Board of Irrigation, Drainage and

Highways. This decision follows one of the big engineering lessons of war experience, that it is possible to build light-weight that is possible a higher quality of performance and reliability, lighter weight coming from the elimination of the many unnecessary parts used in the water-cooling system. The decision of the Nebraska legislators gives the scientific light-weight car the recognition due because of its greater utility and admits that the lighter vehicle is entitled to lower tax rate because the wear on highways is so much less and consumption of natural resources, like gasoline and tires is also a minimum.
