He followed this absolute surprise with the statement that the part of "Canny" was to be played by Theodore Roberts, the distinguished character actor, who created the part in the original stage version in New York eighteen years ago. Those who know "Arizona" and Mr. Roberts will agree that no better selection could have been made.

Canny has a peculiar philosophy, applying to women, which he sums up in one of his speeches:
