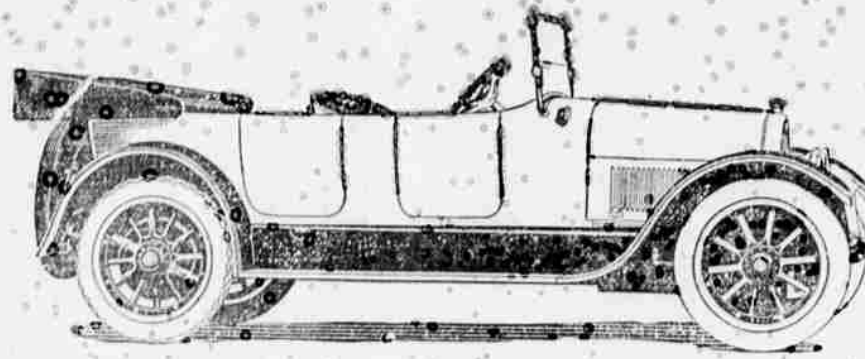


Fourth of July in La Grande

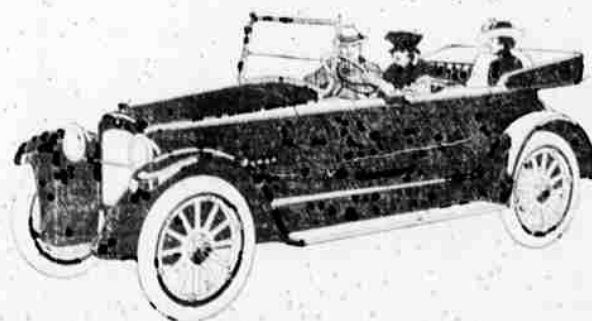
