BLANCH SWEET MAKES HER SCREEN "RE-DEBUT"

CORVALLIS, June 21.—The largest enrollment in the history of boys and girls club work in Oregon—approximately 16,000—is reported by H. C. Seymour, state club leader at the O. A. C. convention in its progress. The club work, with its exception of summer, for which the closing date is July 15. Sewing club work leads in interest with an enrollment of 3,000 and cooking comes second with 2,600 in round numbers. Nearly 1500 young people are enrolled in poetry club work, between 1,000 to 1,200 in the big club work, and 2,000 in the other club projects.

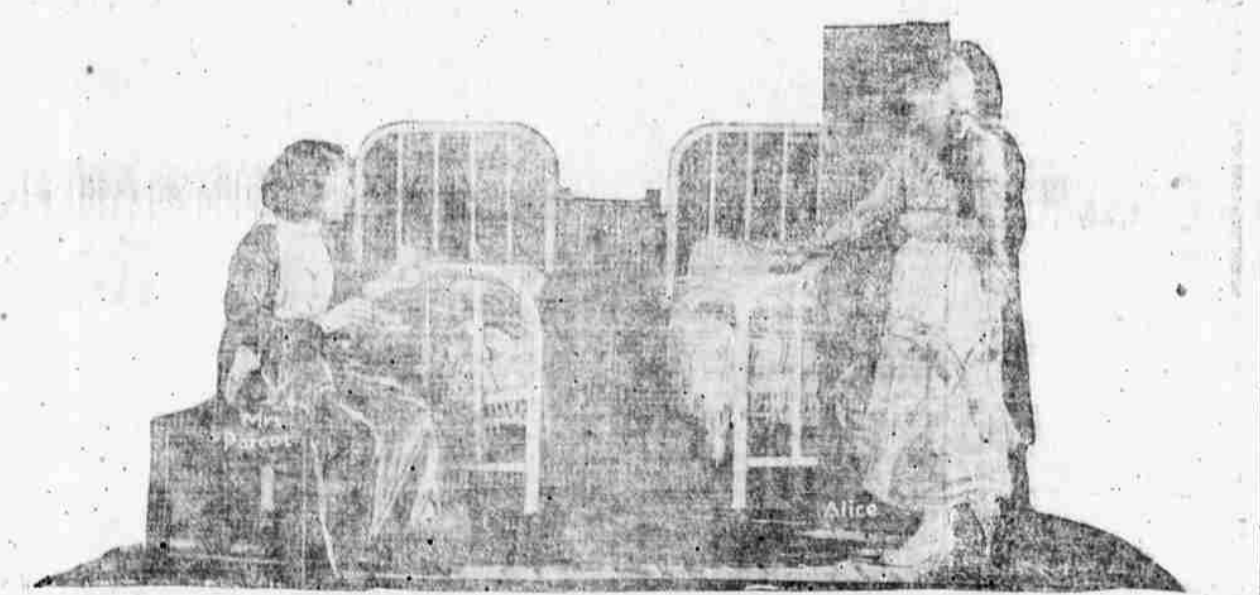
