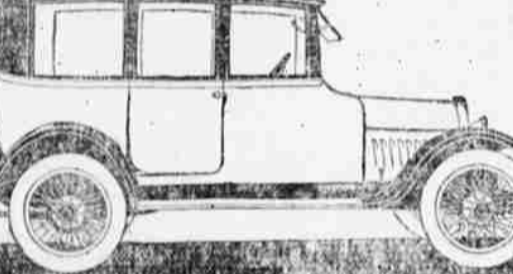

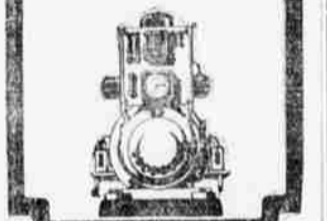

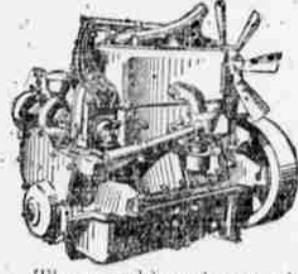

An Engine Built For Service

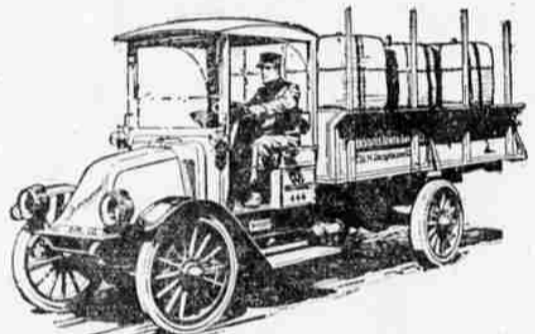

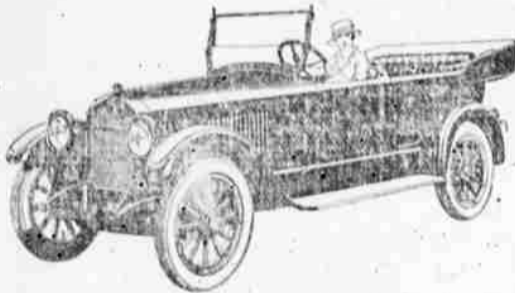

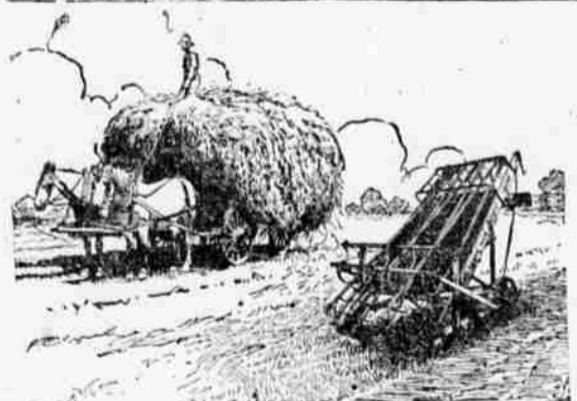
