#### GERMAN OPERA GIRLS WIN IN A STRIKE

BERLIN. (Correspondence of the Associated Press)—The actresses, chorists and stage hands of the German Opera House at Charlottenburg, after a five days strike, have forced the withdrawal of Otto Neumann Neuberger, its director-general, with whom the employees had been in conflict for several years. The force of the Opera house numbered five hundred, went on strike without warning.

Socialist members of the Charlottenburg town council, condemned the cause of the strikers and demanded that the Board of Directors remove Herr Neuberger. Resulting the faculty of further negotiations, he resigned. It was charged that he consistently opposed all social reforms in favor of the employees and was unyielding in his discipline.

The incident was one of the most sensational episodes in the history of German grand opera and the occurrence would have been impossible under the old political dispensation.

#### MAY DIE FROM INJURY James Doyle, Mill Worker at Baker Seriously Injured in Accident

BAKER, July 15.—As the result of an accident while at work at the White Pine Lumber company, James Doyle, about 45 years of age, of 2306 Third street, lost at the point of death in St. Elizabeth's hospital. At about 3 o'clock yesterday afternoon Doyle was accidentally struck on the

head by a saw. The injured man was rushed to the hospital, and Dr. Thomas J. Higgins was summoned. Upon examination on the operating table it was found that the entire front of the man's head was crushed and part of his brain mashed. The doctor had but little hope for Doyle's recovery. Doyle has a wife and a child.

BOARDS TO CONSOLIDATE WASHINGTON, July 15.—The War Trade Board has become a division of the State Department in accordance with an executive order. While all functions and records of the board are transferred to the department, this will not affect or inconvenience importers or exporters in any way. It is said, as all decisions will continue to be issued and correspondence conducted in the name of the War Trade Board.

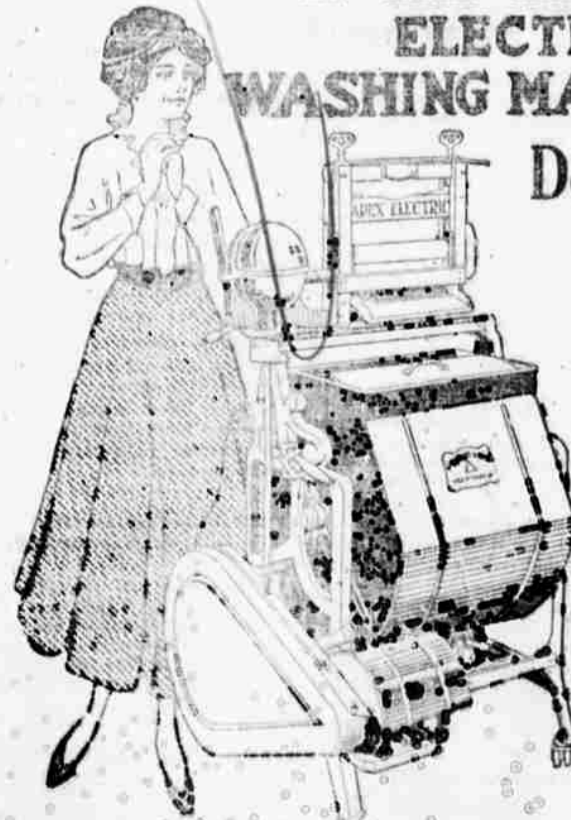
