ORDINANCE NO. 889 SERIES 0000.
An ordinance regulating the leaving and parking of vehicles upon the streets and alleys within the city of La Grande, Oregon; providing for punishment of a violation of the terms of this ordinance and repealing all ordinances and parts of ordinance in conflict herewith.

The City of La Grande, Does Ordain as Follows:

Section 1.—From and after the taking effect of this ordinance it shall and will be unlawful for any person to leave or park any vehicle in or upon that portion of Adams avenue in the city of La Grande, Oregon, between the east line of Fourth street and the west line of Greenwood street; provided however, that a vehicle may be stopped or left standing on said Adams avenue between the east line of Fourth and west line of Greenwood street while such vehicle shall be loading or unloading its load of passengers or freight or for a space not to exceed thirty minutes (30) while the driver or occupant of such vehicle is transacting business on said Adams avenue or in the stores, shops or offices thereon.

Section 2.—From and after the taking effect of this ordinance it shall and will be unlawful and wrongful for any person to leave or park any vehicle in or upon any alley of the city of La Grande, Oregon, provided however, that a vehicle may be stopped or left standing in an alley for the time and for the purposes provided in section 1 of this ordinance as to the stopping and leaving of vehicles for loading or unloading, or while business is being transacted.

Section 3.—From and after the taking effect of this ordinance it shall and will be unlawful and wrongful for any person to leave or park any vehicle upon any street or avenue within the city of La Grande which is not exceeding 40 feet in width between curb lines, except as in this section provided. Upon streets not exceeding or under 40 feet in width between curb lines vehicles when parked or left shall be left or parked close up to the curb line with the right side of the vehicle next to the curb, the vehicle being parallel to the curb or curb line and with a space of not less than 4 feet between vehicles so parked or left.

Section 4.—On all streets and avenues except upon narrow streets or avenues as provided for in Section 3 of this ordinance, vehicles left or parked where the same are allowed to be parked or left under this ordinance, shall be placed with the right side of the vehicle toward the curb or curb line and upon an angle with the curb line and with the front of the vehicle toward the curb or curb line and upon such an angle with the curb line that such vehicle when left or parked will not extend into the street a greater distance than 12 feet from the curb or curb line, and not otherwise.

Section 5.—No vehicle shall be parked or left standing within 10 feet of any fire hydrant within the city of La Grande nor in front of a police station nor in front of any building or house, where the fire truck or apparatus is kept or stationed.

Section 6.—The City Manager is hereby instructed to place on Adams street and the west line of Greenwood street and the east line of Fourth street signs stating thereon in as few words as conveniently possible that by order of the city commission no parking of vehicles is allowed between the points mentioned.

Section 7.—In any prosecution under this ordinance or the violation thereof in the municipal court it shall not be necessary to allege in the complaint therefore any exception contained in any provision hereof but the fact that any vehicle left or parked was so left or parked while loading or unloading or while business was being transacted as provided in this ordinance may be shown in defense and not otherwise.

Section 8.—Any person convicted in the Municipal Court for a violation of any form of this ordinance shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$2.50 nor more than \$50.00 or by confinement in the city jail not to exceed twenty-five (25) days or by both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court.

Section 9.—That all ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed so far and so far only as the same are in conflict with the terms of this ordinance as to the matters herein provided for and to those only.

Section 10.—Whereas, the leaving and parking of vehicles upon certain portions of the streets and alleys of the city of La Grande, has become and is a public menace, and inconvenience and it is necessary that a change be made at once regarding the parking and leaving of vehicles, it is therefore ordered that an emergency exists and this ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage and approval.

Passed and adopted by the Commission of the City of La Grande Oregon, on this 25th day of June 1919, by three (3) commissioners voting thereon.
