### IMPROVEMENT IN MOVIE PHOTOGRAPHS

(By Associated Press to The Observer)  
LONDON, July 22.—A Mollock has attracted attention by exhibiting before the Royal Society a new form of cinematograph which, it is said, will prove of distinct value.  
At present pictures are often shown at a rate considerably higher than at which the photographs were taken in order to avoid the flickerings due to intermittent illumination. Mollock's model, it is claimed, illuminates the screen continuously, thus allowing the picture to be shown at any rate desired—either slower or faster than the speed at which the events occurred.

Notice is hereby given to all concerned, that the City of La Grande, Union County, Oregon, intends and proposes to improve Improvement District No. 100 in said city in the manner hereinafter specified and that the preliminary assessment therefor has been made and is now on file in the office of the Recorder of said city:

That the boundaries of the said Improvement District No. 100 as finally adopted and which is proposed to be improved are as follows: Commencing at the center of the intersection of tenth street and M street now called M avenue, in Coggan's Addition to La Grande, Oregon, and running thence west along the centerline of M avenue to the center of the intersection of said M avenue and ninth street in said Coggan's Addition, thence south along the centerline of ninth street to the center of the intersection of said ninth street and L street, now called L avenue, in said Coggan's Addition, thence east along the centerline of said L avenue to a point south of the southeast corner of Lot 4, Block 18 of Coggan's addition to La Grande, Oregon, thence in a straight line to the northeast corner of said Lot 4, thence east along the north line of Lot 5 in said Block 18 to the center of Tenth street and thence north along the centerline of said Tenth street to the place of beginning.

That the proposed improvement is to consist of constructing from the west line of tenth street to the east line of Ninth street along the south

side of M avenue and from the south line of M avenue along the east side of Ninth street to the north side of L avenue, five-foot concrete sidewalks in accordance with the plans and specifications therefor adopted by the City Commission and filed in the office of the City Recorder on the 17th day of June, 1919.

That the total estimated cost of such improvement is the sum of \$458.21 and the City proposes to make such improvement at the expense of the property in said Improvement District to be benefited thereby.

That the City Commission of the City of La Grande, Oregon, will meet on Wednesday, the 30th day of July, 1919, at 8:00 p. m., in the Commission Room in the City Building at La Grande, Oregon, and hear and determine all remonstrances, objections and claims of grievance of all and any persons to or against the said proposed improvement of the proposed assessment therefor.
