## State News

Major W. Carlton Smith, of Salem, has received from the war department a commission as major in the medical reserve corps of the army. Dr. Smith held the rank of major in the regular army when he served with the 21st Division in France.

Two letters dated July 7 and 10, received by Mrs. O. Bennett from her son, Walter McClure, who was reported dead, seem to be conclusive evidence that the young man is still alive and that the mistake in the name, made by the officials at Hoboken, N. J., accounts for the news received.

Attempting to relieve his hat, which had blown off, E. L. Akers, for the past month employed by Penland Brothers and Pendleton, fell backwards from the running board of a Penland truck crushing his skull to such an extent that he died the following morning at St. Anthony's hospital.

Charles Connors, Haines bank robber, who was arrested in San Francisco and later brought back to Baker by sheriff Anderson, changed his

plea of not guilty to guilty and was sentenced by Judge Anderson to a term of 15 years in the penitentiary.

### NUMERICAL STRENGTH OF THE MEXICAN FORCES.

MEXICO CITY, July 23.—The strength of the Mexican army is placed at 17, 725 officers and 119, 323 men, in an article recently published by Captain Francisco Lazcano who is referred to by the newspapers here as being in a position to speak with accuracy. According to his figures, which are based on reports for the month of April, there are two generals of division, eleven generals of brigades, forty-eight brigadiers and 843 Jettas (chiefs) whose ranks have been recognized by the government as permanent. There are, however, 15,461 generals, chiefs and subordinate officers who are serving temporarily.
